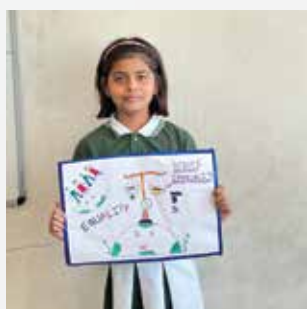
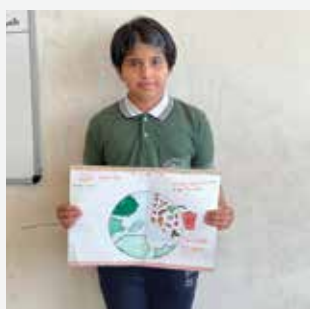

Mother's Day Celebration – Nursery to P-II

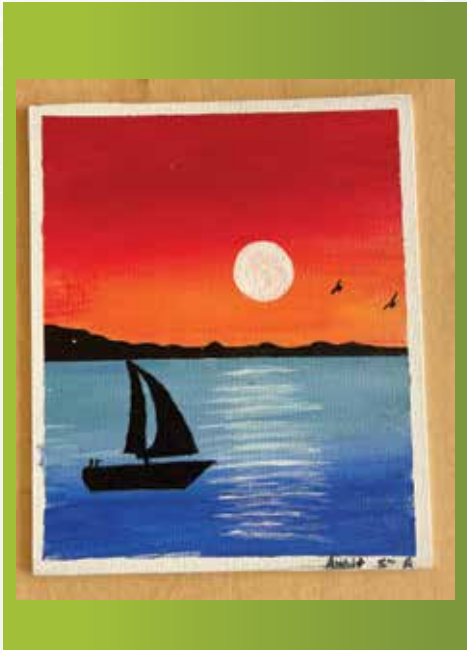

It was truly a heartwarming experience that highlighted the special bond between a mother and her child.



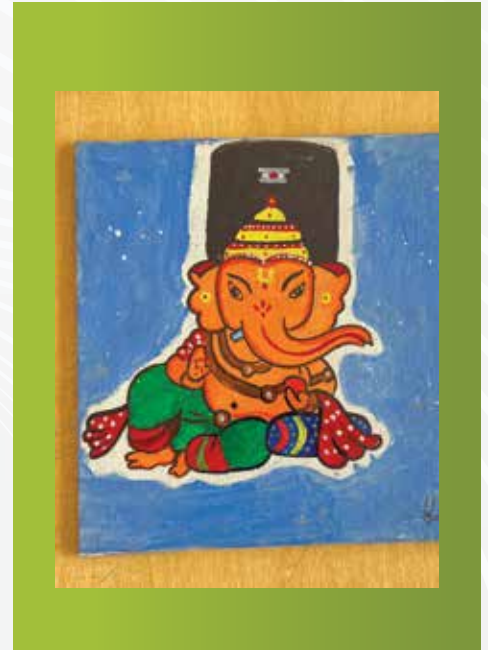

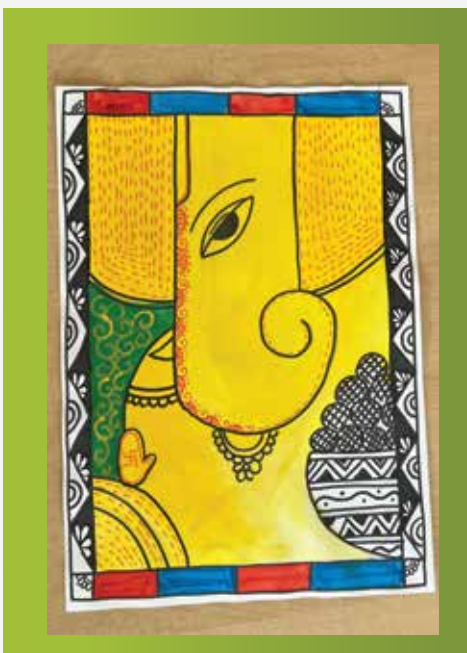

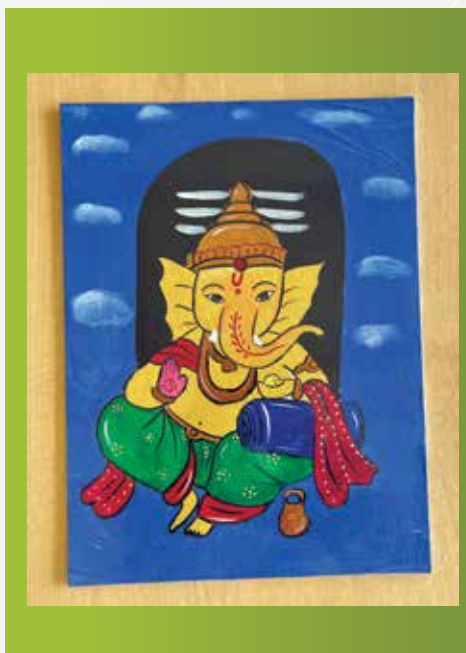
